Presentation of Reports

Committee Reports

ARC – Board Liaison Tiffany Williams informed the Board of an unresolved issue involving the use of different materials for walkways in Ibis Roost. The ARC has asked the sub-association's Board of Directors to select one material for the neighborhood.

Financials – Denise Eidal provided an overview of the organization's December 2020 financials. BHA fared well financially in spite of the COVID pandemic. Careful management throughout the year allowed the organization to end the year with a net income of approximately \$30,000. Greater than budgeted income was from late fees, ARC review fees, *Island Report* ads, and uncollected violation fines. Expenses were \$35,000 lower than the 2020 budget due to less money being spent on payroll, health insurance, transportation, marketing and common area tree management. Not including owners on the quarterly payment plan, only seven property owners have not yet paid their 2020 assessment.

Executive Director report – Carrie Moffett discussed repairs that were needed to the Palmetto Cove dock for safety reasons. Carrie requested that \$3,335 be utilized from Palmetto Cove's reserves to pay for the repairs.

The Board asked Carrie to meet with Village Manager Chris McCall to relay the Board's desire to work with the Village on better management of the Island's vegetation, specifically through the work done by landscapers. A letter from the Board will be forthcoming to give to the Village Council.

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Old Business

Wildlife Overlook Update – John Fisher provided an update on progress toward the construction of the Overlook. While there are logistical challenges to overcome, John is still working with Trinity Builders in an effort to complete the construction by early spring.

Annual Meeting – Carrie Moffett reviewed the mechanics of the Annual Meeting being held the following day. While still meeting the requirements of Governor Cooper's executive orders for COVID-19, several staff members will be on hand to produce the meeting and to facilitate questions by the membership. After the meeting, the 2021 Board will convene to elect officers for the year.

2021 *Meeting Schedule* – The Board discussed holding the 2021 meetings on the second Friday of each month with the exception of the months of February and October. The annual Board Retreat will be held on February 17th with a brief amount of time set aside for regular business. Robert Drumheller requested that the October meeting be moved to Monday, October 11th due to a previous conflict. The Board agreed to the final schedule.
