So, how does she do it all?

Pam's all about staying ahead, not catching up. "I believe in a proactive approach to maintenance and repair work," she says. By regularly reviewing budgets and inspecting properties throughout the year, Pam spots potential issues long before they become problems. Take Surfman's Walk, for example: the budget had allocated \$75,000 to replace fencing in 2026. But after a close inspection, Pam proposed a smarter solution—power washing and painting both sides of the fences. The result? The fences gained at least four more years of life, and the homeowners saved \$59,000.

It's clear that Pam doesn't just work on the island—she cares deeply about it. Whether she's walking a property line, answering a resident's question about trimming tree limbs, or finding creative ways to stretch a budget, Pam Rainey is quietly ensuring that Bald Head Island stays beautiful, functional, and well cared for—today and for years to come.
