NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL OF BONDS

NOTICE is hereby given of intention of the undersigned to file application with the Local Government Commission, Raleigh, North Carolina for its approval of the issuance of bonds of the Village of Bald Head Island, which bonds shall be subject to approval of the voters of the Village at an election and shall be for the following purposes and in the following maximum amount:

\$52,255,000 of bonds to pay capital costs of providing public transportation facilities, including ferry and ground transportation assets and related facilities and property.

Any citizen or taxpayer of the Village of Bald Head Island objecting to the issuance of any or all of said bonds may, within seven days after the date of publication of this notice, file with the Local Government Commission and with the undersigned a written statement setting forth his objections. The statement shall set forth each objection to the proposed bonds and shall contain the name and address of the person filing it.
